Admission Policy

The admission policy for the B.Ed. and M.Ed. programs aligns with the guidelines set forth by MG University, Kottayam, ensuring a transparent and merit-based selection process. The institution is dedicated to foster future educators and prioritise adherence to eligibility criteria, reservation norms, and fee structures in accordance with the regulations defined by the university and NCTE.



ADMISSION TO B.Ed PROGRAMME

The admission to 2 year B.Ed.Programme is conducted by the University through the centralized allotment process (CAP) of M G University, Kottayam.

1. Eligibility for admission, norms for admission, reservation of seats for B.Ed. Degree Programme shall be according to the rules framed by the university and NCTE from time to time.

2. The strength of the college is fixed at 50 students per year and a total of 100 for two years.

3. No student shall be admitted unless he / she pays the fee as per rules and produce all the certificates of qualification mentioned below:

i) Transfer certificate from the college last attended

ii) S.S.L.C.

iii) Qualifying Degree certificate & Mark list

iv) Course & conduct certificate

v) Migration certificate (in case of graduates from other universities)

vi) Community certificate in respect of backward class students

vii) Eligibility and recognition certificate from students who graduate from universities outside Kerala.



ADMISSION TO M.Ed PROGRAMME

The admission to 2 year M.Ed. Programme is conducted by the University through the centralized allotment process (CAP)of M G University, Kottayam.

1. Eligibility for admission, norms for admission, reservation of seats for M.Ed. Degree Programme shall be according to the rules framed by the university and NCTE from time to time.

2. The strength of the college is fixed at 50 students per year and total of 100 for two years.

3. No student shall be admitted unless he / she pays the fee as per rules and produce all the certificates of qualification mentioned below:

i) Transfer certificate from the college last attended

ii) S.S.L.C.

iii) B.Ed.Degree certificate & Mark list

iv) Course & conduct certificate

v) Migration certificate (in case of graduates from other universities)

vi) Community certificate in respect of backward class students

vii) Eligibility and recognition certificate from students who graduate from universities outside Kerala.



FEES

1. Every student shall on admission pay the full amount of fees prescribed for unaided course including caution deposit.

2. Receipts signed by the accountant will be issued on the realisation of all kinds of fees, fines and other dues

3. Students belonging to SC / ST are exempted from paying the caution deposit

4. Fee Concession : Students belonging to SC /ST /OBC can avail fee concession if they produce caste & income certificate at the beginning of the course and apply in the prescribed form. Students belonging to OBC are eligible for fee concession only if their annual income comes in the prescribed limit as per the government norms



Procedure for Applying to Community Merit Quota Seats

- Procedure for Applying to Community Merit Quota Seats
- Apply to Merit Quota seats first (through MGU CAP)
- After the final submission of application to Merit quota seats, candidates who wish to apply for Community Merit quota seats may choose the option corresponding to Community Merit quota.
- In the case of Community Merit quota, select the community applicable to the candidate.Upload the digital copy of the community certificate issued by the competent revenue authority.
- Register options
- Submit the application

Procedure for Applying to Sports/Cultural Quota Seats

- After the final submission of application to merit quota seats, candidates who
- wish to apply for sports quota seats may choose the option corresponding to
- sports quota In the case of sports quota, select the sports event applicable to the
- candidate and details corresponding to the category.
- Upload the digital copy of the relevant document
- Register options
- Submit the application



Procedure for Applying to PD Quota Seats

- After the final submission of application to Merit quota seats, candidates whowish to apply for PD quota seats may choose the option corresponding to PD quota.
- In the case of PD quota, select the disability category applicable to the candidate and details corresponding to the category.
- Upload the digital copy of the disability Certificate
- Register options
- Submit the application
