




WORKSHOP ON VARIED STUDENT NEEDS 22 AUGUST 2020 TO 24TH 2020




WEBINAR on MANAGING ADOLESCENT LEARNERS DURING COVID PANDEMIC

Aim


- To develop skill in script writing to B Ed students




2. ARIKE-LEARNING SUPPORT TO STUDENTS IN COVID TIMES
