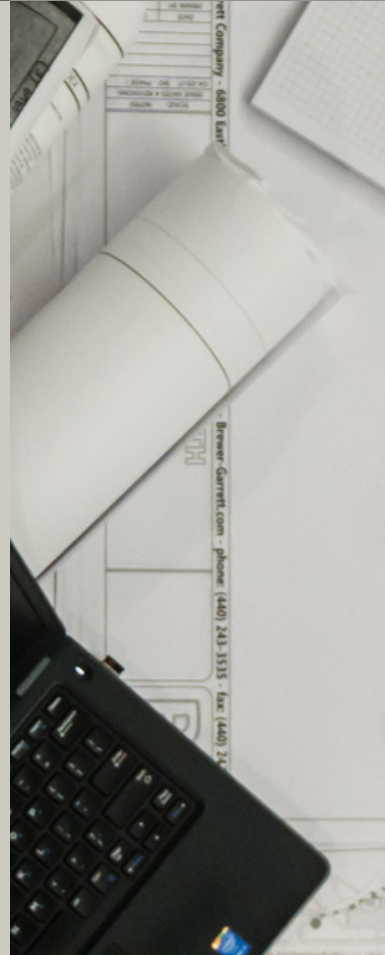


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BEST PRACTICES

They gained expertise in creating multimedia-based educational content like short films, documentaries, developing educational blogs, producing and uploading videos in YouTube channels, and utilizing the i-Learn MOODLE platform for academic and non-academic activities. Several online tools have been introduced to serve a variety of purposes.

The training has provided practical experience and instilled environmental consciousness. PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED



Challenges encountered include limited resources, resistance to change, time limitations, and sustainability concerns. Additionally, issues regarding trainee diversity, assessment methods, and technological barriers are significant hurdles in these initiatives

BEST PRACTICE 2:

SEVANA - SOCIAL INITIATIVES OF SNM TRAINING COLLEGE

THE CONTEXT

In our rural community, educational opportunities are abundant, but awareness of current social trends is limited among the residents. Our college's "SEVANA" social initiatives are designed to address this disparity by promoting a well-rounded and informed lifestyle within our local community. These initiatives also aim to raise awareness about recent societal trends and events. The college remains committed to its vision of empowering students to respond positively to societal issues.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE



- Foster social awareness among students by facilitating hands-on experiences within the community.
- Enhance community knowledge of contemporary societal trends and local events.
- Empower students to cultivate leadership, teamwork, and administrative skills.

PRACTICE

SNM Training College introduced the "Grama Sevana Padhathi" (Village Service Project) to support Ward VI of the Vadakkekara Grama Panchayath. This strategy successfully identified and met the pressing needs of the local community to enhance the village's overall well-being. Social services were divided into five key priority areas, and students were assigned to each category, under the supervision of faculty members. They are,

1. Parenting
2. Environmental protection / Awareness
3. Citizenship Awareness
4. Health Care
5. Language and culture



PRACTICE

The introduction of a mobile library (Chalikkunna Pusthakasala) has played a pivotal role in promoting language and culture. During the COVID-19 pandemic, healthcare assistance was provided through video classes, and essential resources like masks, sanitizer, fogging machines, and TVs for online learning were distributed in the village. Additionally, to assist the community during the pandemic, vegetables were also distributed. Various awareness activities, including flash mobs and street plays, were organized to inform and educate the community.

IMPACT OF THE PRACTICE

SNM Training College's "Grama Sevana Padhathi" initiative, assisting Ward VI of Vadakkekara Grama Panchayath and categorizing social services into parenting, environmental protection, citizen awareness, healthcare, and language and culture, has effectively elevated the community's quality of life.

PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED



The "Grama Sevana Padhathi" initiative faced challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic, limited student availability, and tight academic schedules, budget constraints, and a shortage of volunteers for all these activities, which affected the depth and effectiveness of the services provided.



RESOURCES REQUIRED

To successfully implement the "Grama Sevana Padhathi" initiative, essential resources include dedicated faculty and student involvement, funding for operational costs, materials and supplies relevant to program activities, community engagement, and access to technology and communication tools.
