




#### • WORKSHOP ON ADDRESSING INCLUSIVENESS IN CLASSROOM

felicitation was delivered by teacher coordinators of Literary club Dr. Susmita, Dr. K.S


Krishnakumar and Heera K.S. It was followed by the most beautiful moment where the editor


Holistic Wellness in her welcome note. She appealed to the teaching fraternity to work collectively to improve the physical, spiritual, social and quality of the students.



### AWARENESS TALK ON RAGGING & CYBER LAW






WORLD FOOD SAFETY DAY – JUNE 7, CELEBRATION




#### TRAILBLAZING-2K22


### • SPEECH COMPETITIONS

#### • FIND YOUR VALENTINE





### • MAGAZINE RELEASE












# • QUIZZ COMPETITION




A Quiz competition for first year B.Ed students was conducted on March

# • ASSIGNMENT- Pedagogical Activity




As part of pedagogical activity, Curious minds – science club of SNM Training college, Moothakunnam organized a session, 'Assign assignments' through the method of brain


#### **BRAINSTORMING**

## • INTERNATIONAL BIODIVERSITY DAY






#### • ONE DAY SEMINAR ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY




• SREE NARAYANA ACADEMY OF VALUE EDUCATION (SAVE)


water. The theme was selected to make the world aware about this fact and get involve in problem solving.
