Profile of the College

S.N.M Training college is owned by Hindu Matha Dharma Paripalana Sabha, a voluntary organisation formed in 1882 by the spirited youth of backward Ezhava Community in the Vadakkekara region under the guidance of Ashtavadhani Parisudha Vishista Paranatha Khanadana Venkatagiri Sasthrikal, an Andhrith theologian who pioneered Hindu Matha Parishath Movement, with an aim of promoting vigorous campaign for social justice and liberation from social bondage.

The college was established in 1960 for Bachelor of Education, as an arduous task of imparting teacher education to the weaker sections of the society. The college has set up a tradition of its own with regard to the decorum and decency of its student teachers. The college is situated at Moothakunnam on the banks of the mighty Periyar river in the vicinity of the famous Sankaranarayana Temple. As the college is by the side of NH 66 and is just 4 km away from Kodungallur the very famous ancient port town of Musiris, it is easily accessible by road. The nearest railway station is at Aluva 15 km away. The calm and serene atmosphere is quite and conducive for intellectual pursuit. The college has an intake of 50 B.Ed.students every year.

In December 2005 the college started post graduate course in Education, (M.Ed.) with an intake of 25 students. From 2015 onwards the intake has been increased to 50 students.

3. No student shall be admitted unless he / she pays the fee as per rules and produce all the certificates of qualification mentioned below:

- i) Transfer certificate from the college last attended
- ii) S.S.L.C.
- iii) B.Ed.Degree certificate & Mark list
- iv) Course & conduct certificate
- v) Migration certificate (in case of graduates from other universities)
- vi) Community certificate in respect of backward class students
- vii) Eligibility and recognition certificate from students who graduate from universities outside Kerala.

Fees

1. Every student shall on admission pay the full amount of fees prescribed for unaided course including caution deposit.
2. Receipts signed by the accountant will be issued on the realisation of all kinds of fees, fines and other dues
3. Students belonging to SC / ST are exempted from paying the caution deposit
4. Fee Concession : Students belonging to SC /ST /OBC can avail fee concession if they produce caste & income certificate at the beginning of the course and apply in the prescribed form. Students belonging to OBC are eligible for fee concession only if their annual income comes in the

Refund of Caution Deposit Rules

3. If the student takes T.C. before the completion of the course, the caution deposit will be refunded before the closing date of the college

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Conditions for Loan of Books

Period of loan for general books will be 14 days. Books on loan can be renewed for 14 days. The library staff may fix a shorter period of loan for a book that is in great demand, from circulation without assigning any reasons thereof. Defaulters will have to pay a fine of Rs.1 per day.

The loan facility is restricted to members only. They must borrow books personally.

- ★ Loose issues and bound volumes of periodicals are not issued out.
- ★ The librarian reserves the right to recall any book from any member at any time.
- ★ Books on loan may be renewed for further period provided that no other member had reserved the same.
- ★ Readers should verify the condition of the book, and should inform the librarian about the discrepancies, if any, before borrowing.

Loss of Books

- In case of loss of book the borrower shall replace the book within 20 days, and the defaulters will be charged 3 times the price of the book.
- If a book from a multiple volume set is damaged or lost, the member is liable to replace the whole set or pay the cost of the entire set. However, the librarian has the discretionary power to take the final decision.

General Rules

- All members are requested to maintain absolute silence in and around the library.
- Members shall not engage in conversation (including subject discussions) in any part of the library so as to cause annoyance to any other reader.
- Members shall not write upon, damage or mark any book belonging to the library.
- Users are not permitted to alter the arrangements of tables, chairs, etc., made in the library.
- Members shall not bring personal belongings (bags, text books, files, printed materials etc.) inside the library. Members may leave them at the property counter kept outside the library.
- The librarian reserves the right to suspend the membership of any member found misbehaving in the library.
- The members caught tearing pages of books/ stealing books will be suspended forthwith from using the library facilities and the library will recommend for further disciplinary action against them.
